### **GREAT TRUTH** FOUR

Though There Is Only One True God, This God Exists in Three Persons—the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit

Many people in the world believe there is only one true God. However, the Bible teaches us something about this God that we cannot learn anywhere else. The Bible teaches that this one God has existed from all eternity in three "persons" known as God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. This teaching of one God in three persons (called the Holy Trinity) is very difficult for us to understand or explain. However, we accept it as the way God has made Himself known to us.

In Lesson 5 we will study about God the Son who came to earth as Jesus Christ. In Lesson 8 we will learn more about God the Holy Spirit. In this lesson we simply note that the Father is God, the Son is God, and the Holy Spirit is God—and that these three are the one true God.
